

St Peter's Cambridge - Robb Sports Centre Courts Rules and Guidelines

There is no unauthorised public access to the Robb Sports Centre at any time.

The organiser of the user group is required to sign a Robb Sports Centre Usage Declaration' form in order to use the courts.

Access & Responsibility

- The courts are to be accessed through the main doors at the front of the building
- Access to the courts is by St Peter's swipe cards only.
- The card holder must be present in the courts.
- Users must produce their card and identify themselves on request.
- The use of the gymnasium does not permit use of the weights room, squash courts or climbing wall unless specifically included in the written agreement.
- You (the organiser) are responsible for any spectators and must ensure children are supervised at all time and stays off equipment.
- Please ensure the courts & upstairs area are left in a tidy state and all rubbish has been removed or placed in the rubbish bins provided.
- All spectators must sit upstairs on the tiered seating (no one to be standing upstairs on the PE classroom side)
- No sitting on the climbing wall pads
- Please do not remove any equipment from the courts.

Court Use

Rules for courts – These rules can be shared with players, coaches and management

- Appropriate footwear to be worn (No school shoes, high heels, gumboots, jandals etc)
- T-shirts/singlet's must be worn at all times.
- No chewing gum to be in mouths while playing sport
- No food to be eaten on the courts or courtside.
- No drink bottles on courts, water courtside only (no sports drinks).
- Only management and players to be on courts/courtside. All parents, children etc must watch from upstairs.
- Teams – please bring own first aid such as strapping tape, plasters etc
- No access upstairs by the classrooms. If you want to video from this area please get permission from the floor controller.

Completion of court use

- Please put equipment back where you found it (ie scoreboards off and away)
- Ensure lights are all off and doors are closed. Please also remember to check changing room lights and doors.

First Aid

- In case of an emergency please dial 111
- The hire must ensure adequate first aid coverage for all participants (or inform teams to bring their own), in the nature of first aid kits and qualified first aiders.
- If there is a fire, please exit by the nearest door if safe and meet by the tennis courts where the fire brigade will meet you.

AED's

Locations:

- Outside the Health Centre
- Outside the Robb Sports Centre

These are accessed by dialling 111 and obtaining a pin number to open the AED. This also alerts the ambulance service that an AED is required and will send an ambulance to the location.

Safety
Whilst every precaution has been taken to ensure safety in and around the court area, anyone using the courts and the available equipment does so at their own risk.
General
The Trust Board may vary these rules and guidelines from time to time and reserves the right to restrict or remove access to any court user who does not comply with these Rules and Guidelines.
