ENTRY CRITERIA

Competitors must be the correct age for the category they are entering and should attach photocopy proof in the form of (Birth Certificate, Drivers Licence, Passport). Age is measured at 1/1/2022

Only competitors who attend school in this region are eligible to enter this event. Contestants must be enrolled at a NZ secondary school in years 9-13 and have the release forms signed by their school principals.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection of a regional team to attend the National Scholastics Championships at Taranaki 10-14 October shall be at the discretion of the team selection committee. Team members will be selected in accordance with the Coromandel Regional Scholastics selection criteria.

REGISTRATION:

All participants will meet at 8:00am at event location. If the contest cannot be completed on the preferred date it will be completed on one of the back-up dates. The contest site will be determined at each event depending on conditions.

FORMAT:

Single Elimination Format (ISA rules); where 1st and 2nd progress to the next round. A second chance format will be put in place if time allows.
