FAQ SHEET

Q: Will the fees increase to cover the cost of lights and line marking / field set up?

A: Grant applications will be investigated to offset costs for the 2024 season and WaiBOP Football have committed to working with clubs and Council to assist with these costs for the 2024 season.

Q: Will students need to leave school early to play?

A: Games will be scheduled at times and venues that do not disrupt academic learning time

Q: Will this increase the midweek loading for players who are involved in both school and club teams?

A: Clubs and schools will need to ensure that scheduling is co-ordinated for these players and that loads are managed accordingly.

Q: What will happen if games are cancelled due to the weather or ground conditions? When will re-scheduling occur?

A: As is currently the case, when postponements occur, teams can agree to play on an available date later in the season. Designated 'catch-up' midweek dates will be available.

Q: Are there going to be enough fields available for the competition?

A: Yes.

Q: Will there be enough referees available to officiate midweek games?

A: Yes. Waikato Referees have indicated they will be available for calendared midweek fixtures.

Q: Will the games be scheduled at times that allow parents to watch after work?

A: Games will be scheduled in the late afternoon/evening which will allow parents/supporters to attend as suits.
