Registration Steps

We have spoken to School Sport NZ and have managed to work together to streamline the steps in registration to make things far easier for schools. Schools will now only need to submit one principal's signature during the registration process.

Once you have submitted the online form attached to this email, we will set each of your school's teams up on Friendly Manager with the name format "School Name Seniors Girls B" (for example) using the school administrator's name as filled out on the above registration form. The school admin must then log onto Friendly Manager and add your two players and coach to their respective teams. I have also attached a PDF detailing this process step by step to this email.

Once you have imputed your team lists, all you need to do is print it off using the below blue 'generate report' button, have your principal check and sign the list, and send it back to this email address (vnz1@volleyballnz.org.nz). You will then be completed with your registration!
