NEW RULE rider can ride 2 pony/horses in different heights or same height in same team however, (if rider has 2 mounts in same class can only select 1 to do jigsaw) if riding by yourself you will be partner with another rider

For primary and intermediate riders only. Teams do not need to have riders in both rings. Total of four riders to make up a team. Schools with less than 4 riders may apply to the organiser to be randomly allocated a draft rider for the whole day. Please state on Evo Entry. Schools do not make up their own combined teams. Combined teams will compete against all other teams. Jig Saw event partners will be decided by the gate steward prior to the event.

- Teams wanting to ride up in ring 1/2/3 will have to compete against secondary school competitors. They can still score points, only if they score in the top 10. No separate intermediate or primary placing in the each of the classes in ring 1, 2, 3.

Conditions: This event will run under NZEF rules and regulations. Refer to the NZEF website to familiarise self with these rules. www.nzequestrian.org.nz/jumping/competition/rules. **By entering a team/s agree to abide by the rules of the day. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entries, alter, amend, add, divide or cancel classes as they deem necessary. Please nominate one liaison person per school. The liaison person is responsible for ensuring team riders, coaches, schools and parents are given all information pertaining to the day.**

Clothing: Teams must wear team uniform clothing. No riding jackets allowed. Yellow tagged helmets a must

Parking: Team floats and trucks park in their areas

How to enter – Schools (or appointed managers) enter through EVO EVENTS stating what school and team name, if rider not registered on Evo Events its easy to arrange this, and pay entry at this time

General: No dogs allowed on the grounds. Team/coaches/TIC's are responsible for ensuring their riders' gear is safe, well fitted and in good repair, and that all riders wear a well fitted approved yellow tagged safety helmet while mounted. Schools **must** provide helpers as allocated by the organisers. (rail and gate stewards).

School Teams: Secondary School Teams consists of 4 riders from Yr 9 – 13. From the same school with at least 1 rider in each ring (junior, Intermediate, Senior). Primary School Teams consist of 4 riders (<Yr 9) either choosing from heights 50-60 or 60-70. Both heights will be in ring 4. With the same event following each other. E.g. 50-60 cm TAM5, 60-70 cm TAM5.

In the interest of Fairplay and the spirit of School competitions it is expected riders will jump their usual heights.

Points: Secondary School competition points will be given for the first 10 individual placings in each class (or shared in case of equality). 1st = 10pts to 10th = 1 point. Ribbons awarded to the 1st and 4th place getters in these classes. Rosettes will be awarded to the teams placed 1st and 6th overall. Secondary School Teams will be placed separately from Primary and Intermediate School teams. The winners will become the Waikato champions in each division.

Prize giving: Will commence at the conclusion of the day – Unmounted, there is only a trophy for Secondary Schools competition

Entries close: Friday 23th Feb 2024, **EMAIL** to confirm team entries, questions **or changes** *(Do not call or txt regarding draw changes/scratchings, these will only be made via an email with all details of the change or scratching provided in the email!!)*
