NZSSAA Cross Country Regional Relays 16 June Christchurch 2024

Information for athletes

Based on the success of the last several years, 2024 will again see a regional relay event held as part of the New Zealand Secondary Schools Cross Country Champs in Christchurch. Athletes will compete in relay teams of four runners each completing 2000m (2 x 1km lap). Three divisions across girls, boys and mixed (2 girls/2boys) grades will provide a competitive and spectator friendly event. In addition, there will be para athlete relays available in the three divisions with 4 athletes each running 1km.

8.30am Final confirmation of changes to Boys team names in running order 8.45am Boys Relay Y9, Junior and Senior grades including Boys Para teams. Each athlete completes 2 laps (Para athletes 1 lap) of the 1km course 8.55am Final confirmation of changes to Mixed team names in running order Mixed Relay Y9, Junior and Senior grades including Mixed Para teams. Each athlete 9.25am completing 2 laps (Para athletes 1 lap) of the 1km course 9.35am Final confirmation of changes to Girls team names in running order 10.05am Girls Relay Y9, Junior and Senior grades including Girls Para teams. Each athlete completing 2

laps (Para athletes 1 lap) of the 1km course

Medal ceremonies for the top 3 teams will be approximately 10 minutes after each event.

Selection to represent your region will predominantly be taken from today's regional championships. Final team selections will also take results from the Saturday championships into consideration. Please note that you will be representing your region and not your school so a different uniform will be required to compete in. A Waikato/BOP team singlet will be available for use on the day should you not already have one of your own. Black shorts must be worn.
